DATE:	SECURITY OBSERVATIONS & INCIDENTS:
07/01/15	There was an irrigation leak at 14825 N. Moon Valley Dr.
07/02/15	At 2135 Security Officer P. Duke II found a truck door open and unattended at 201 E. Forest Hills, he also notified the resident about his open garage door.
07/03/15	At 1945 Security Officer D. Emerson received a call from a resident on Moon Valley Dr in regards to suspicious activity at his home. The resident was on vacation and asked to have his home checked. Officer D. Emerson went to the address and found a pillow torn up on One of his outdoor chairs but all the doors and windows were secure with no signs of a break-in. The resident is a subscriber but didn't inform us he was leaving town, he said he will do so in the future. We added him onto our vacation watch list until he returns.
07/03/15	Shortly after 0300 Security Officer D. Emerson was stopped by a woman while patrolling the neighborhood and told the resident was missing a relative. The missing man was intoxicated, diabetic and was possibly in an altercation with his wife earlier. Due to the situation Officer D. Emerson contacted the Phoenix Police Department. To our knowledge it's unknown if Phoenix Police Officers were able to locate the man in question. The gentleman lives in an apartment complex North of Moon Valley.
07/07/15	At 2114 Security Officer B. Ledbetter received a call from a concerned resident about several teenagers lighting off fireworks behind 2 E. Canterbury Ln. The homeowner said the teens fled the area when they saw our security patrol enter the area. Officer B. Ledbetter searched the area with no further signs of the teens in question.

07/12/15	At 0912 Security Officer P. Duke was stopped by a resident who was looking for his missing dog. Both dogs had gotten away but he had found One and asked Officer P. Duke if he'd keep an eye out. The missing dog is a mostly White Labrador with some brown spots.
07/15/15	At 2345 Security Officer D. Emerson received a call from a resident that was concerned about a Red Jeep Az plate # THKUHP parked in the road close to the Country Club. The vehicle is parked and looked to be a guest of a resident at 301 W. Moon Valley Dr.
07/20/15	Officer B. Ledbetter found a broken sprinkler head next to the mailbox at 158 W. Boca Raton Rd.
07/23/15	At 0100 while patrolling the neighborhoods Security Officer D. Emerson saw that a couple Cactuses were toilet papered at 413 W. Gleneagles Dr.
07/24/15	At 2000 there was a medical emergency at 309 W. Conrad. Phoenix Police, Phoenix Fire Department and Crime Scene technicians were on scene. No information was given but there was no threat to the community.
07/27/15	While patrolling the neighborhoods Security Officer B. Ledbetter found a broken sprinkler at 641 Port Au Prince Dr. The resident didn't answer the door so they could be notified, a note was left on the screen door.
07/31/15	A storm that hit the community knocked a couple power lines down across from the elementary school on Central. Several APS, Phoenix Police, Phoenix Fire and news crew were on the scene for several hours throughout the afternoon and into the early morning of Saturday. As far as we know there were no injuries reported on several residents without power.
